

#### AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves) or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

#### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC. (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

IMPORTANT SHOW INFORMATION**

Unsigned Entries Cannot Be Accepted. Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms, Downloaded and/or Photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries received without fees will not be accepted.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Post Dated Checks, Returned Checks and Declined Credit Cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check or declined card. Subsequent returned checks or declined cards from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Errors on Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Each Owner and Agent listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

In the event that it becomes necessary to rescue an animal from a parked car on the show grounds or in the parking areas immediately surrounding the show grounds, the club will not be held liable for any damages incurred a result of rescuing the animal(s). Furthermore, if the rescue has to be performed by virtue of negligence, the owner, agent or any other person responsible for the rescued animal WILL be subjected to an Event Committee Hearing as approved by the rules of the AKC. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal or external parasites, and communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations

During the 1970's I was in the US Navy stationed on Whidbey Island, Washington. Nearby was an OES kennel, Driftwood Kennel, run by Hazel Foster Collins. She took me under her wing and mentored me for four years. This was an education that money could not buy. Here I learned from kennel management to grooming to showing and breeding. Hazel was a wonderful teacher and friend, I owe her a lot.

Upon discharge from the Navy I went home to New Jersey, via Maryland to visit with Barry Goodman, Rivermist Kennel. He was planning a breeding that he thought was very exciting. From that breeding, came my Rivermist Lilac, a beautiful bitch that did well in the show ring. At that period it was nothing to have entries of 25 – 30 OES on any weekend. Barry Goodman, a master with the brush and scissors, he tutored me in the art of presenting the OES. Unfortunately Rivermist Lilac was not able to be breed.

During all this time I became friendly with Carol Ghee, Rolling Gate Kennel. Carol was very generous with her knowledge. From her I got my Rolling Gates Mrs. Witherspoon. Also during this period I was a neighbor and friend of Serena and Hendrick Van Rennselear, Fezziwig Kennel. Their reputation here in the US is legendary in the Old English Sheepdog world. My involvement with this wonderful breed has been on-going through the years. I have been privileged to judge Specialty Shows and many supported entries.

It was during the early 70's that I met and fell in love with the Bearded Collie. There were barely a handful of Beardies in this country. At one point ½ the Beardies in the US sleep on my bed. I leased a lovely bitch and bred her. That was the beginning of a 30 year love affair with Beardies; A wonderful breed. I showed and finished any number of Beardies. I lost my last three Beardies last year at, 20, 18 and 17 years old.

Also during this time I acquired a PBGV. Then, another and another. I bred a few litters and finished a couple. I breed the first PBGV to get championship points in the US. I also bred the first PBGV bitch to get an Agility title. I was on the committee that wrote the standard. During this time I was involved in 2 Kennel clubs and started the first Herding Group Club. A club dedicated to the advancement of herding breeds. We were the first Herding Group in the US to hold an AKC championship show.

**ROUTES TO THE SHOW GROUNDS**

**From The North**

Take I-83 S to Exit 22 (N. George St.). At first traffic light, make a right. At the second traffic light, make a right on to 30 W. Stay in right hand lane and watch for Carlisle Ave./Rt. 74 Exit.\* At end of exit, turn left at traffic light on to Carlisle Ave (74 S). Stay in left-hand lane. The expo center is approx. 1 mile on the right-hand side.  
\*Approx. 3 miles

**From The South**

Take I-83 N to Exit 15 (S. George St.) At the third traffic light (Country Club Rd.) make a left. At the second traffic light (Richland Ave.) make a right turn; stay on Richland Ave until the sixth traffic light (W. Market St.) make a left. The expo center is approx. 2 blocks down on the right-hand side.

**From the East**

Take Rt. 30 West to Carlisle Ave./Rt. 74 Exit. At end of exit, make a left at the traffic light (74 S). Stay in left-hand lane. The expo center is approx. 1 mile on the right-hand side.

**From the West**

From Rt. 30 take Route 462 (W. Market St.). Follow Market St. to Highland Ave. Turn left onto Highland Ave. to the expo center on right. (Highland Ave. Gate 6)
